Dear Harrisburg High School, John Harris Campus Students, Parents and Families,

The 2022-23 school year is off to a great start, and we are continuing to refine our policies and procedures to ensure a safe and productive learning environment for all.

Effective **Monday, September 26**, the following adjustments will be made to our morning entry procedure:

1. *Students arriving after 9:00 a.m. will be required to have a signed, written note from a parent or guardian and/or have a parent present to enter the building. Students arriving after 9:00 a.m. without a note and/or a parent will not be permitted to remain on campus.*
2. *Once students arrive at school, they should enter the building immediately. Students should not leave campus to go to neighboring establishments to include stores and restaurants in the Kline Village Plaza.*

As a reminder, the following entry expectations will remain in place:

1. *Students may begin entering the building starting at 7:15 a.m. through the Kimber gymnasium.*
2. *Students may move to advisory at 7:40 a.m. and Advisory will begin at 7:45 a.m.*
3. *Students arriving after 7:50 a.m. will enter through the front entrance on Market Street.*
4. *Students should be in uniform each day. Ripped jeans, hats, hoods, ski masks, and sunglasses **ARE NOT** permitted to be worn in the building. Students arriving out of uniform will be asked to change. Those students who continue to arrive out of uniform are subject to progressive discipline and consequences.*
