Homebound Instruction:

- Homebound Instruction offers students Core classes only. (i.e. Math, English, Social Studies, and Science)
- Homebound instructor/tutor will provide 5 hours of tutoring instruction and be in contact with student by phone minimally once a week to assure student is completing course work
- All equipment is the property of the Harrisburg School District
- Student and/or Parent/Guardian will attend orientation meeting to complete all paperwork and receive equipment

Homebound Medical:

Overview:

- Students who have a medical prescription signed by a licensed physician stating unable to attend school full-time or part-time due to a medical condition
- State the student's medical diagnosis
- Physician must indicate time frame of medical condition not to exceed 45 days in length
- The licensed physician must be in the medical practice/field of the diagnosis
- If physician indicates an extension is needed a new script must be presented every 45 days
- **Students on homebound medical may not exceed 3 months of instruction unless an extension is filed with the Pennsylvania Department of Education**
- Students are afforded the opportunity to maintain grade level content coursework

HOMEBOUND INSTRUCTION STUDENT RESPONSIBILITIES

- Agree and follow all policies outlined in the Harrisburg School District— including agreements for Homebound Instruction
- Log in and complete daily lessons.
- Contact tutor or Homebound Administrator with any questions or problems while accessing courses via online on books via email or phone.
- Notify Homebound Department and provide change in phone number, address, and medical condition
- Use appropriate language and proper grammar and spelling when sending electronic communication.

*** Failure to comply with rules and responsibility could lead to termination of Homebound Instruction, and other arrangements will have to be made.**
